Words of the Cross: Today, you will be with me in paradise By Paul Webster

Main Points:

1. There were two types of people at the cross: Those who rejected Jesus and those who accepted Him as Savior.

Reasons for People's Rejections:

- Misunderstanding the purpose of Jesus' death.
- Minimizing the need for salvation.
- Mocking Jesus despite His kingship.

2. The cross means we must choose a response to Jesus.

The cross is the heart of the Gospel and the only hope for humanity. It reveals God's love, mercy, grace, and justice. We must all make a personal decision regarding Jesus at the cross. Accepting Jesus leads to eternal hope and empowerment by the Holy Spirit.

Bottom Line: Eternal hope begins with accepting Jesus and His promise of eternal life.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1. What does the story of the two thieves teach us about the choices we have regarding Jesus?
- 2. How can we ensure we are not minimizing our need for Jesus in our daily lives?
- 3. In what ways can we reflect on the purpose of Jesus' death and its impact on our lives?
- 4. How can we share the message of the cross with others in a way that invites them to make a personal decision about Jesus?
