- 1. The Fulfillment of God's Promises
- The birth of Jesus connects us to God's faithfulness.
- Isaiah's prophecy to King Ahaz serves as a testament to God's covenant with His people.
- 2. Prophecy of Immanuel
 - Isaiah 7:14 introduces the concept of Immanuel God with us.
- Historical context: God assured Ahaz He would be with him during Israel's struggle.
 - The fulfillment seen fully in the New Testament through Jesus.
- 3. Mary and Joseph's Role
 - The angel's announcement is a pivotal moment of God's promise.
- Mary's response highlights faithfulness to God, leading to the miraculous birth of Jesus.
- 4. Living in the Tension of Now and Not Yet
 - Emphasis on God's presence amid uncertainty.
- A call to recognize God's ongoing work in our lives, despite challenges.
- 5. Trusting and Acting on God's Promises
- Encouragement to engage with God's Word and trust His character.
- Practical applications: prayer, kindness, and living out God's purpose.

Bottom Line: The promises of heaven are fulfilled through Jesus' presence on earth.
